SPECIAL CALLED SESSION
NOVEMBER 18, 2019**

Be it remembered that the Henderson County Commission met for a Special Called Session on November 18, 2019 at 7:00 P.M. at the Criminal Justice Complex Center.

Commissioner Harold Tyler gave the Invocation.

Commissioner Andy Anderson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The following County Commissioners answered present: Jeff James, Mike Lefler, Tommy Page, Harold Tyler, Aaron Wood, Shana Duke, Terry Allen, Wanda Powers, Andy Anderson, Tim Rogers, and Celia Barrow. Also present was County Attorney, Lena Bell. Commissioners Todd Beecham and Blake Stanfill, Chairman, Eddie Bray, and Clerk, Carolyn Holmes were absent. Commissioner Joe Ross was the Mayor Pro Tempore.

Item I. Motion made by Commissioner Andy Anderson, seconded by Commissioner Harold Tyler to approve the Minutes of November 4, 2019 meeting. Motion carried.

Item II. Motion made by Commissioner Wanda Powers, seconded by Commissioner Shana Duke to approve Zachary Hall, Rosa Hamm, Falen Hasher, Parker Jones, and Mona Roberts as Notaries. Motion carried.

Item III. Motion made by Commissioner Wanda Powers, seconded by Commissioner Mike Lefler to accept the highest bid of \$500,000.00 for the Parkers Crossroads property.
